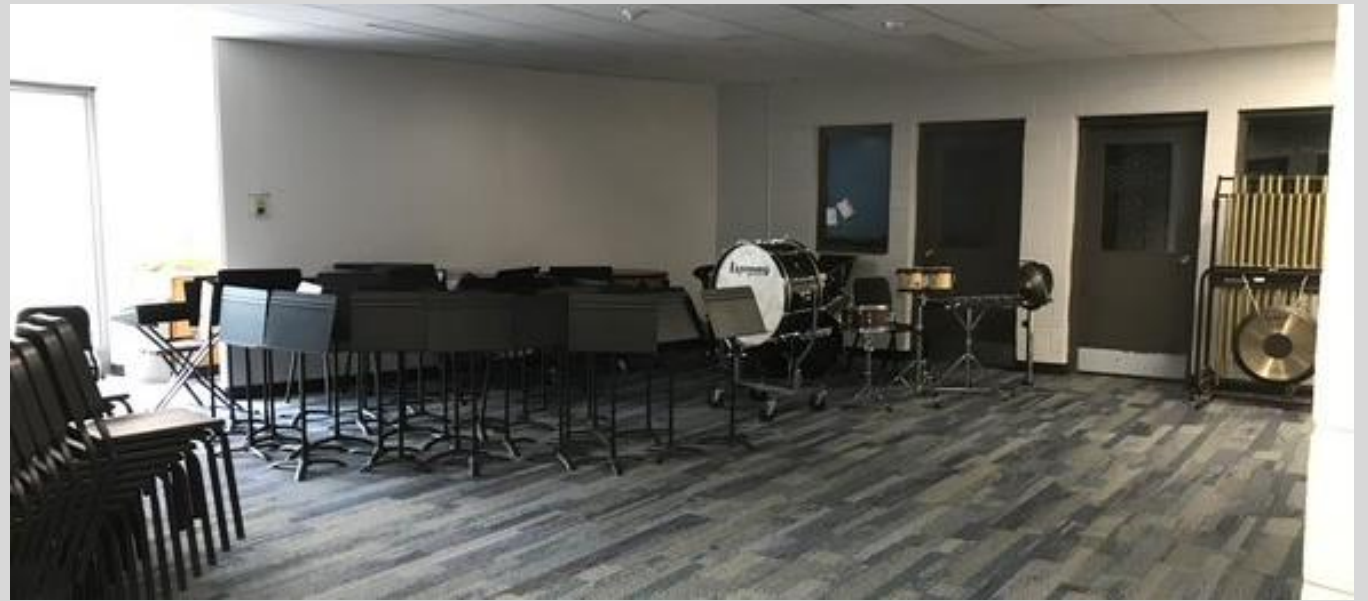




Depending on what's going on, students will eat in the common area or the "caf". You may purchase food from the vending machines or the cafeteria.



This is the “caf”. You may have been here for a performance or recital in the past. The steps at the back are called the “tiered rooms”. There is usually a wall at the back.

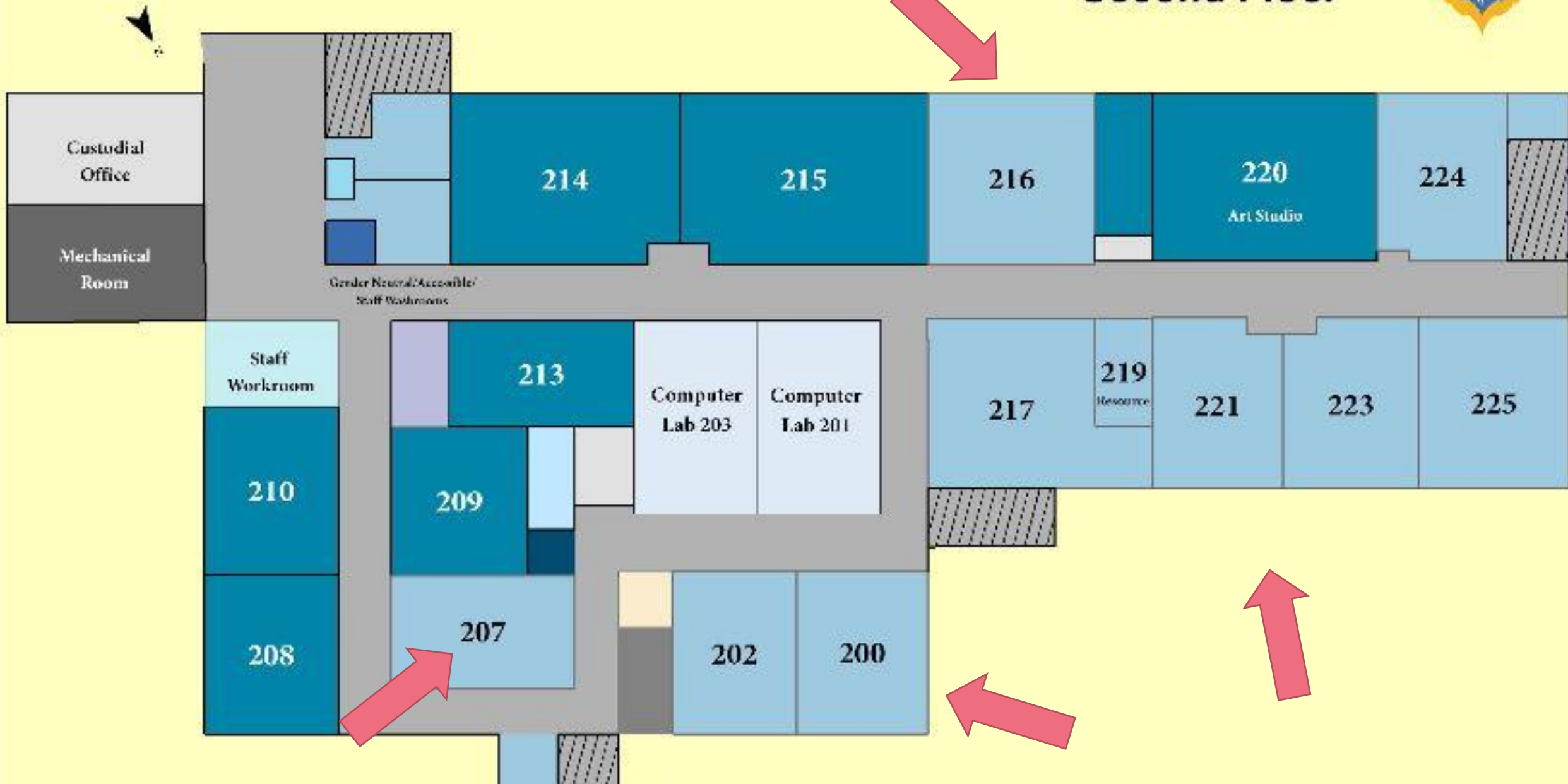


Mr. Patterson is looking forward to being able to host school bands and ensembles again! Be sure to consider joining! 😊

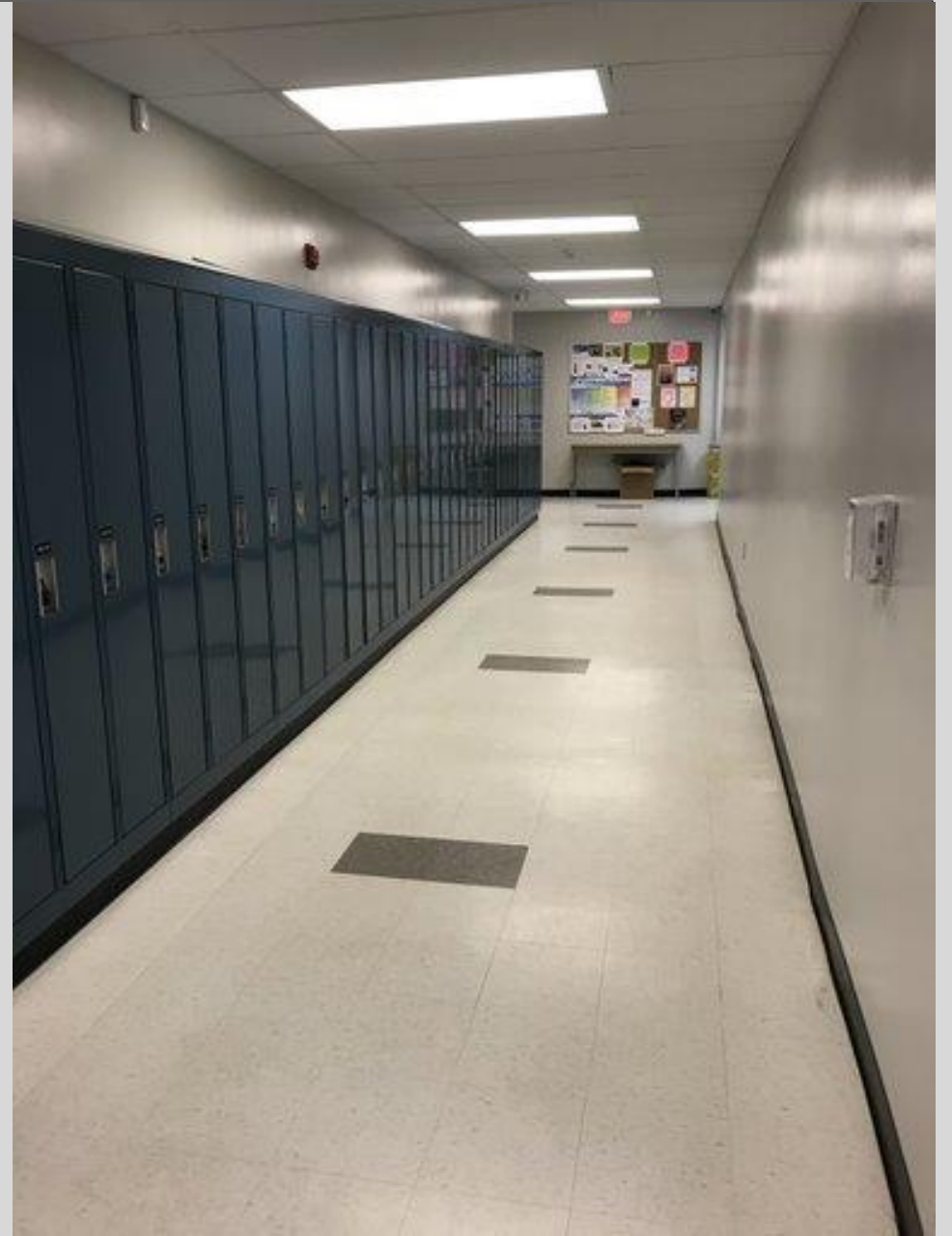

This is Mr. Alexander's grade 7 classroom. All rooms have whiteboards and projectors. 😊





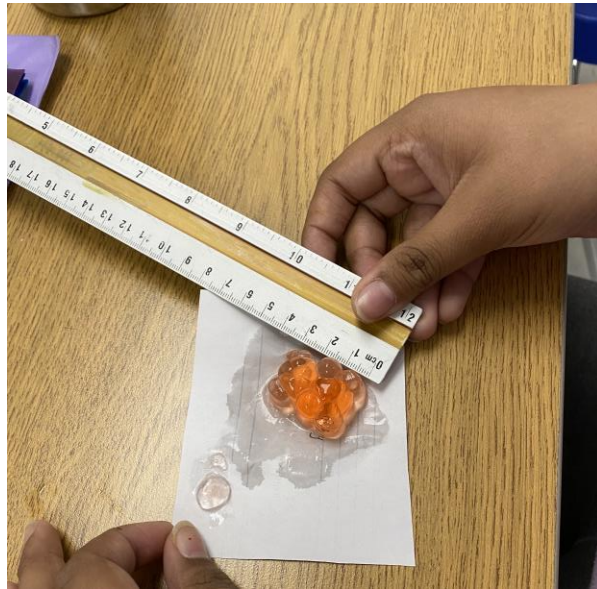
This is Ms. Whyte's grade 8 classroom.

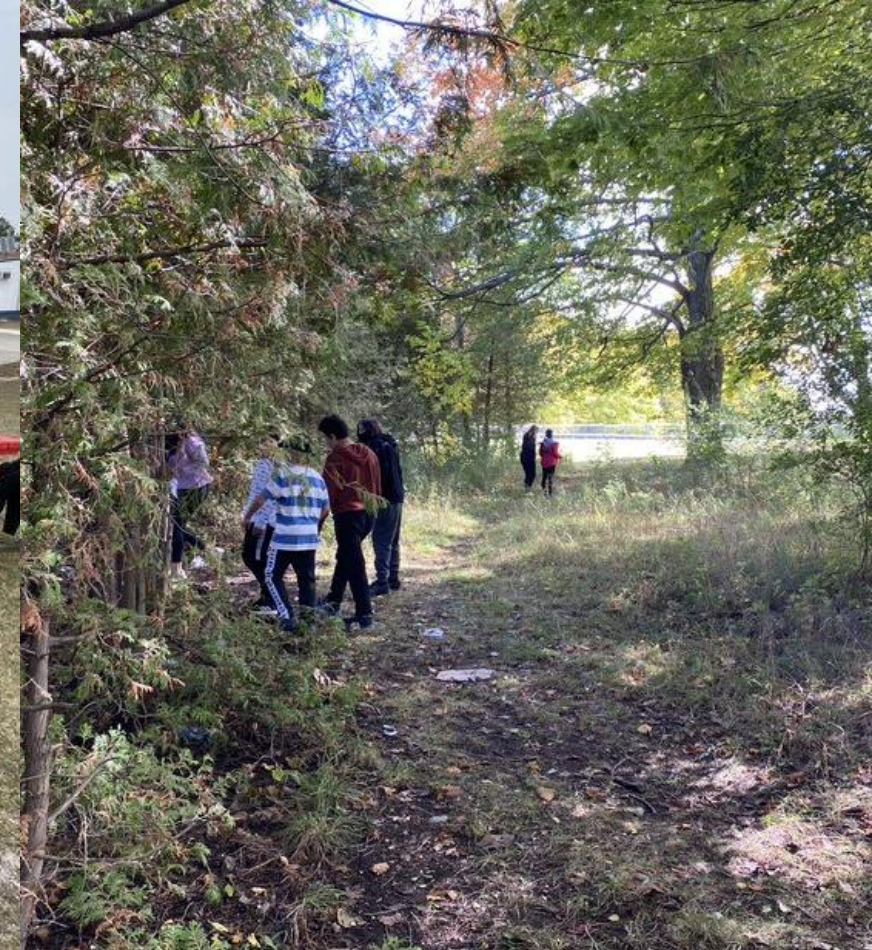




This is Mrs. Sollors' classroom and the view from upstairs.

- Terry Fox Run



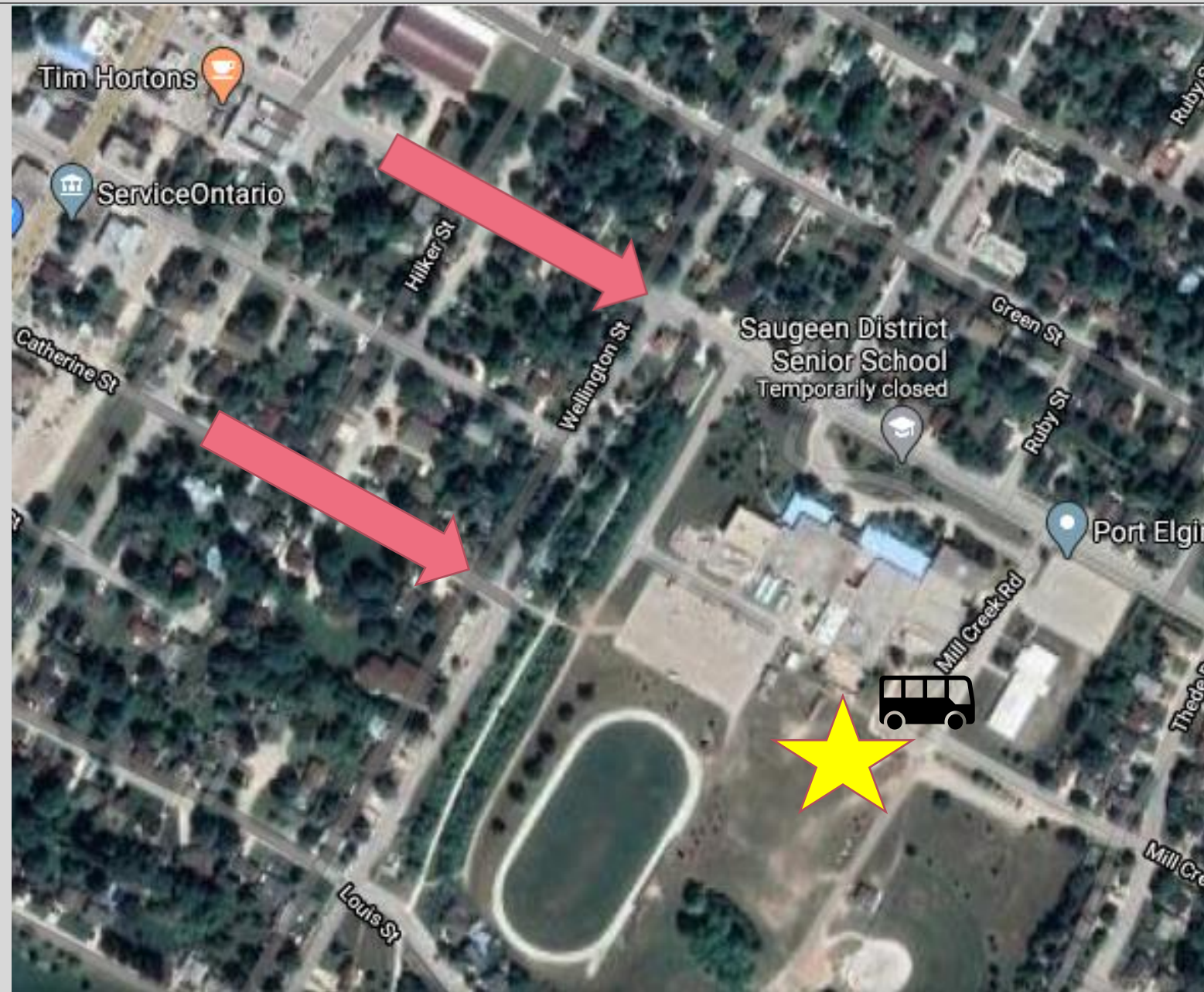
